Steps to Follow When Receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation

- 1. Getting Ready Student should spend some time examining their conscience.
- 2. The student should enter the confessional and greet the priest, i.e., Hello Father.
- 3. Make the <u>Sign of the Cross</u> out loud.
- 4. Recite "Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been ___ since my last confession."
- 5. Offer their sins by saying "I have offended God by these sins: _____"
- 6. Wait for the priest to respond.
- 7. The priest will give the student a penance.
- 8. Student will say the act of contrition with the priest.
- 9. Absolution will be given by the priest.
- 10. The priest will conclude the confession by asking the student to go in peace.
 The student responds "Amen". (If the confession is face-to-face, the priest, depending on personal style, may extend his hand for a sign of peace.)
- 11. Student carries out his/her penance.
